Vineyard Weitgasse- Deep ravines are very typical in loess formations. On the plateau, these ravines open up and become ‘wide’, hence the name ‘Weitgasse’ (“broad alley”) at the end of a hollow way on the high plateau of the mountain. Originally used as a pasture by all the farmers in the municipality, in more recent times it was divided up among all the farmers. With the introduction of high cultivation, it became suitable for wine-growing. The site is mentioned in a church chronicle in 1760.

Tasting Notes Weitgasse strives for a cool, fresh character. The nose should be inviting but not too loud. To enable the wine to achieve this style, it is usually harvested early. The coolness of the site should find its way into the wine.
