Aging 4 months in stainless steel vats

Tasting Notes Mineral and citrus fruitiness, grapefruit, hints of nettle and white flowers, very fresh and light on the palate, revealing the altitude of the vineyards. The soul of this wine lies in the unique combination of the Síria and Fonte Cal native grape varieties, from old vines planted in granite and schist soils with quartz veins, in the Douro River's hydrographical basin, at an average altitude of 700 meters.

Excellent as an aperitif, with appetizers, grilled fish and shellfish and to share with friends!
