CIGAR BOX CABERNET SAUVIGNON

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Vineyard Vineyards are located in Maipo valley - Andes, south of Santiago, at an altitude of 2.300 feet. The trellis system is a VSP with a frame of 2 x 1 (meters), and a yield of 10.000 tons/ha.

Grape Varieties 85% Cabernet Sauvignon
15% Syrah

Vinification Fermented with selected yeasts at temperatures between 25° and 28°C with high color extraction at the beginning of the this process. This was followed by fermentation at a lower temperature to ensure a different extraction of the skin components. 60% of the wine was aged in French oak for 8 months. The remaining 40% was aged exclusively in stainless steel vats until bottling, in order to preserve the original typicity and freshness of the wine

Aging 60% of the wine is aged in French Oak barrels for 8 months

Tasting Notes A deep ruby red wine with aromas that recall ripe red berries, vanilla, caramel and licorice notes. This is a medium-bodied wine, with ripe, robust tannins and a lingering finish.
