Vinification Grapes picked manually in 15Kg cases. The grapes are then destemmed, crushed and transferred into temperature-controlled (23°C–25°C) stainless steel tanks where they ferment for 10 days.

Aging 6 months in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes Clear, bright violet color. Complex red berries, with notes of overripe plums. Rich red berry flavor with great persistence. Balanced and well-rounded with a good structure that will allow it to age well.
